Frequently Asked Questions About Auxilium College, Vellore

How do I apply for admission into Auxilium College?

Students can apply online through the official admission portal of the institution.

What is the admission process followed in Auxilium College?

- For **Aided Programmes**, the admission process is based on the Tamil Nadu Government guidelines for Aided Colleges.
- For **Unaided Programmes**, it is based on marks scored in Tamil Nadu Higher Secondary Board/CBSE/ICSE or equivalent.
- For MBA programme the admission is based on TANCET rank list.

What are the eligibility criteria for admission to the course?

- **Undergraduate Courses (UG):** Pass in Higher Secondary of Tamil Nadu State Board, /CBSE/ICSE or equivalent.
- **Postgraduate Courses (PG):** pass in Bachelor's Degree Programme in the relevant discipline.

Should the applicant pass any entrance examination for admission?

There is no entrance examination, however, TNCET is mandatory for the MBA programme.

Can I apply for admission even if I have a gap in my academic career?

Yes, you can apply for admission even if you have a gap in your academic career.

However, you must provide a valid explanation for the gap and meet the minimum eligibility criteria for the program of your choice.

Can I apply for admission into Auxilium College for the I Year or III years, by way of migration from another higher education institution?

Migration to Auxilium College is possible, provided the applicant obtains clearance from the affiliating university (i.e.) Thiruvalluvar University.

Is Auxilium College accredited by any regulatory council?

Yes, the college is accredited by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) with an 'A+' grade in the 4th cycle.

What are the college timings?

College usually functions from 8:30 AM to 1:30 PM for the shift I and 12:30 PM to 5:30 PM for shift II.

What is the total course fee, including tuition, exam fees, and other charges?

The fee structure varies depending on the Programme.

Does Auxilium College offer scholarships? What are the eligibility criteria to avail Scholarship?

The college offers various scholarships, including those provided by the state and institution based on both merit and reservations.

Can the fees be paid in instalments?

College fee is collected semester-wise.

Is hostel accommodation available within the campus?

Yes, safe and secure hostel facilities are available for outstation students.

Does the hostel mess serve vegetarian or non-vegetarian food?

The college caters to both vegetarian and non-vegetarian (twice-a-week) food.

Does the college have linkages with industry for collaborative knowledge exchange, skill training, internships, and placement?

The college has --- MoUs, --- linkages and ---- collaborations with industry to ensure the effective imparting of knowledge, Integral formation, skills and social responsibility.

Does the college have good laboratory facilities?

The college has well-equipped and specialised laboratory facilities for language, life science, physical science, microbial science, mathematics, and computer science.

Is there high-speed internet and Wi-Fi available for students?

The campus is Wi-Fi enabled, providing high-speed internet to the students.

Does the college encourage extracurricular activities?

The college has a variety of clubs and movements to encourage extracurricular activities and outreach activities.

What is the scope of campus placement in Auxilium?

The Career Guidance and Placement Cell of the college organizes

- Soft Skill training
- Training in employability skills for all the students.

- Campus recruitment for all UG and PG final years, where many get placed in reputed concerns. (More details on the college website)

Does the college provide internships?

Yes, both Undergraduate and Postgraduate Programmes have internships for a semester.

Is there a library facility in the campus?

Yes, the college has a library with thousands of books, e-resources, journals, and a digital repository for reference and research.

Does the college offer value-added courses and certificate courses?

Yes, the college offers **20 value-added courses** like Tally, Soft Skills, Spoken English, Computer Basics, and **7 Certificate courses** on employability and entrepreneurial skills.

Does the college offer support for competitive exams?

Yes, students get coaching support for **NET/SET, TNPSC, and Bank exams.**

How does the college nurture and sustain research?

- Research projects are an integral part of all the programmes offered in college.
- The college has an active committee for research, IPR and Publication.
- The college offers seed money grants to Faculty Members and Research Scholars to conduct impactful research projects.

Are job fairs conducted?

Yes, the college organises **job fairs and campus drives in** collaboration with reputed companies.
