

The principal sister, Dr.(Sr.)Arokiya Jayaceli A, addressed the gathering and motivated the students to showcase their talents.

A key moment in the event was the distribution of Aari kits, which included all the essential tools and materials needed to begin practicing Aari embroidery. Each kit contained Aari needles, wooden hoops, fabrics, embroidery threads, and instructional materials. The distribution of these kits was met with enthusiasm, reflecting the participants' eagerness to immerse themselves in the craft. The Aari course training, which begins on 21.01.2025 and ends on 08.02.2025, promises to upskill the students enrolled in the program.
