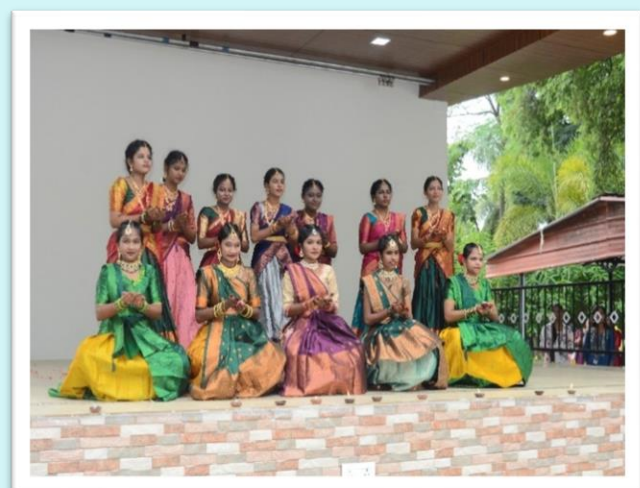

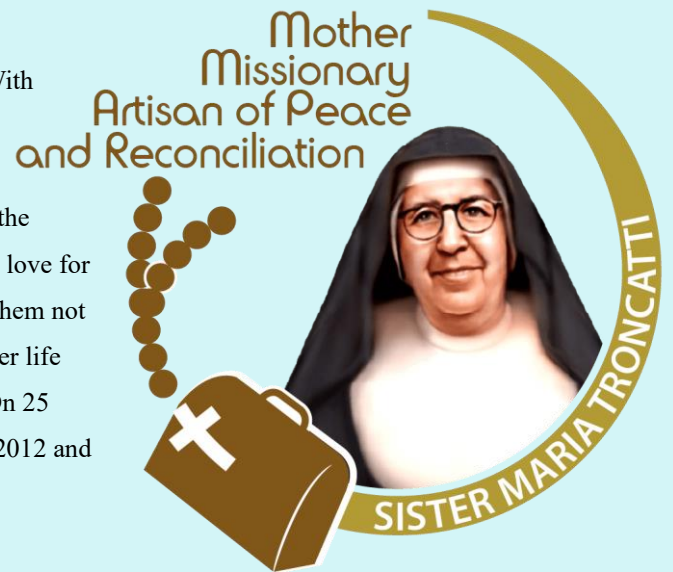
Sr. Margaret FMA

Her life became a shining testimony of her courage, service, and holiness. On 25 August 1969, she died in a tragic plane crash. She was beatified in 2012 and on 19 October 2025, she will be canonized by Pope Leo XIV.

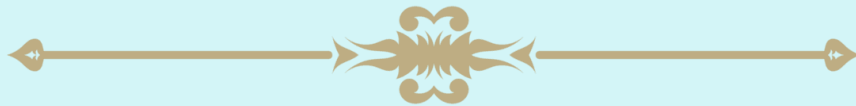
