The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) organized a Capacity Building Programme on NIRF Ranking for all Heads of Departments, Deans, and IQAC members on 06.12.2025. The primary objective of the programme was to strengthen the understanding of NIRF parameters and enhance institutional preparedness for data submission.

The forenoon session, held from 10.00 a.m. to 1.00 p.m., was facilitated by Dr. A. Clement King, Operational Manager, Mount Carmel College (Autonomous), Bengaluru. Dr. Clement King provided a comprehensive explanation of the five categories of NIRF, emphasizing the importance of understanding each parameter thoroughly. He highlighted how every data point must accurately correspond to the question asked, ensuring maximum relevance to secure marks. He also illustrated common data submission errors and offered clarity on aligning institutional achievements with NIRF expectations.

In the afternoon session, Dr. Clement King addressed the IQAC members, focusing on a logistic and systematic approach to NIRF data management. He elaborated on the step-by-step process involving data collection, verification, completion, consistency, and submission. Through practical insights and examples, he stressed the need for coordinated efforts between departments to ensure error-free and timely data submission.

The program proved highly beneficial, equipping the participants with improved clarity on NIRF criteria and strengthening institutional mechanisms for ranking preparation.
