#### 19.06.2020 : Webinar on Solar Eclipse







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Session V: How to give fertilizer and what fertilizer to give at which time.


Session VI: How to prevent the plants from pest & How to recover the affected plants.

Session VII: How to prepare your own fertilizer at home with waste vegetables



#### November 26<sup>th</sup>: National Constitutional Day





### March 19<sup>th</sup> : NSS Volunteers in COVID- 19 Vaccination Camp


