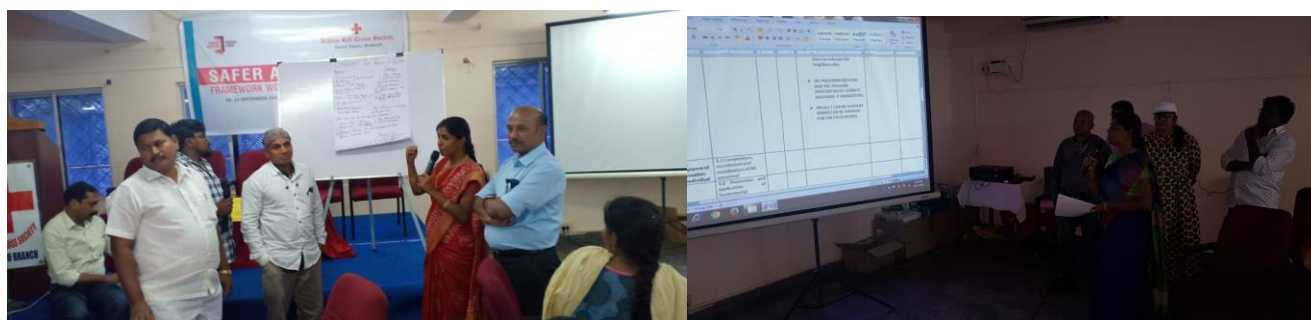
- Safer Access Elements

SESSION 5:

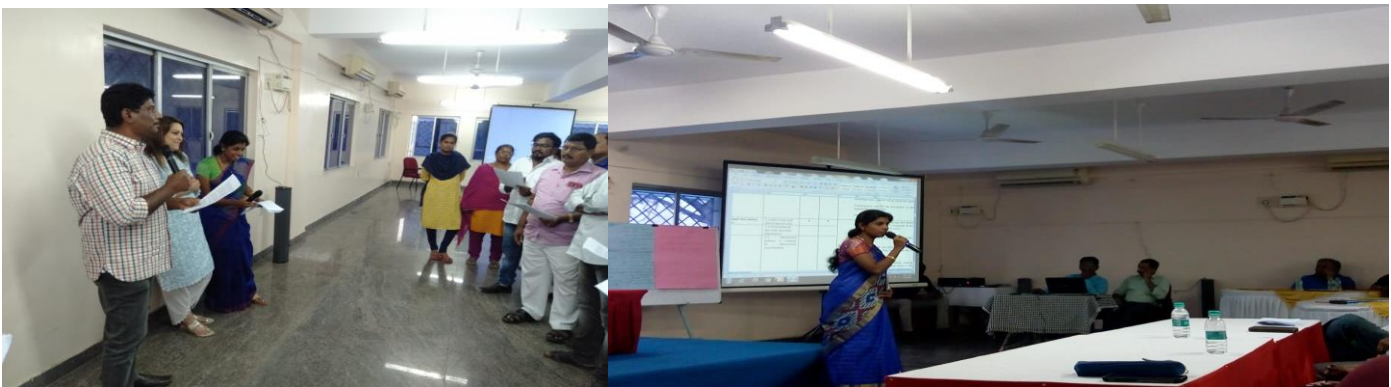

INTERNATIONAL WORLD DISASTER REDUCTION DAY

DATE: 13.10.2019

The National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) - 4th Battalion, Arakkonam, and the Tamil Nadu Fire and Rescue Services, Vellore, conducted an awareness rally with Indian Red Cross Society Vellore District Branch and also conducted mock drills to demonstrate evacuation and rescue methods during earthquakes, firefighting techniques, rescue methods and ways to stay safe during disasters, on the occasion of International Day for Natural Disaster Reduction.

The programme, was inaugurated by Collector A. Shanmuga Sundram on Sunday, He flagged off a rally by school and college students on safety during disasters from the town hall near the Old Bus to Nethaji Stadium, after which a mock drill was conducted at the Nethaji Stadium in Vellore. Firefighters demonstrated methods to tackle blazes created due to oil and short circuits. They demonstrated how injured people trapped in a multistorey building could be safely rescued by using ladders or ropes. They provided helpful tips on how to tackle if someone's garments caught fire and how to treat burn with clean cold water.

On the other hand, the NDRF personnel took students to the places of disasters like earthquakes, with real-time models and made them understand the necessity to behave with alacrity during evacuation at a disaster site or any other accident sites.

In his address, Mr. Shanmuga Sundram told residents of Vellore that the district featured on the list of places at risk of earthquakes and that they have to be prepared to tackle such an eventuality with smartly. He urged them to be alert during rainy days with essential items.



WATERBODIES ENCROACHED

The Collector pointed out the re-emerging trend of encroaching upon water bodies despite the government's effort to relocate them to a safer locality. This was done to keep them safe during floods, he said.

He said a rainfall of 17 cm left many areas of Vellore inundated for a few days. This was because of encroachments in water catchment areas around the city. Efforts were on to identify and relocate the inhabitants of such areas to safer locations. People need to cooperate with district administration in this endeavor, Mr. Shanmuga Sundram added.

Programme schedule Report: Registration for the programme started at 9.30 am in Thiruvalluvar University.

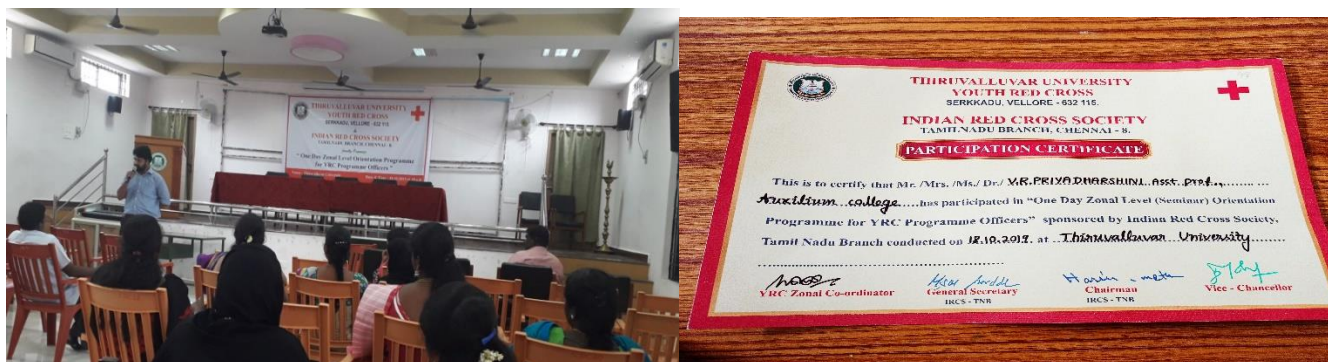

He explained the Red Cross was born in 1863 when five Geneva men including Dunant set up the international committee for relief to the wounded. Later to become the international committee of the Red Cross. Its emblem was a red cross on a white background the inverse of the Swiss flag.

The 2nd session on YRC activities in college was handling by Dr.Ameenal Bibi, Assistant Professor of Mathematics, and DKM College for Women, Vellore. She enlighten the college YRC unit focused on the

following areas, Blood donation camp, Orphanage visit, Anti-smoking, Health screening Camps, Environment awareness camps and Clean and Green country.

The 3rd session on Awareness on Blood Donation handle by Mr. Arul and team, Blood Bank CMC, Vellore. They explain the different situation of patients who needs blood and rules and regulations must follow during blood donation. The regular donors in addition to donating blood should motivate and educate the other people. All one time donors should be made aware that repeated donation at a proper gap of 3 month is an absolutely health practice. Female donors need to be encouraged more. They explain health tips must follow after blood donation. They ask YRC volunteers to spread the knowledge and awareness about blood donation.

The 4th session on Skills was handling by L.M.V. Devakumar, Rtd., CanaraBANK Manager, Vellore. he gave talk about the different skills need to developed by YRC programme officer and student volunteers.



The 5th session on First Aid was handling by Mr.S.N.Janarthanan, District Convener, Junior Red Cross Govt., Girls High School, Katpadi. He gave half an hour video clipping about fire accident and the measures we have to take during fire accident. He explained the types of burns in percentage. He asked all adults in the household know and understand proper first aid, children should be taught general first aid principles.

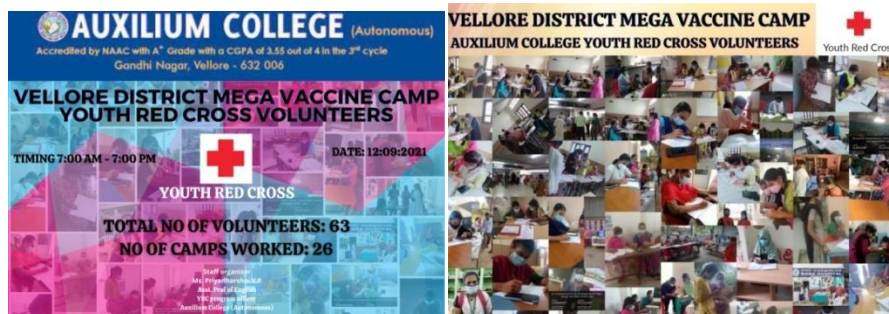
THEME: Tamil Nadu: Mega-vaccination drive against Covid-19

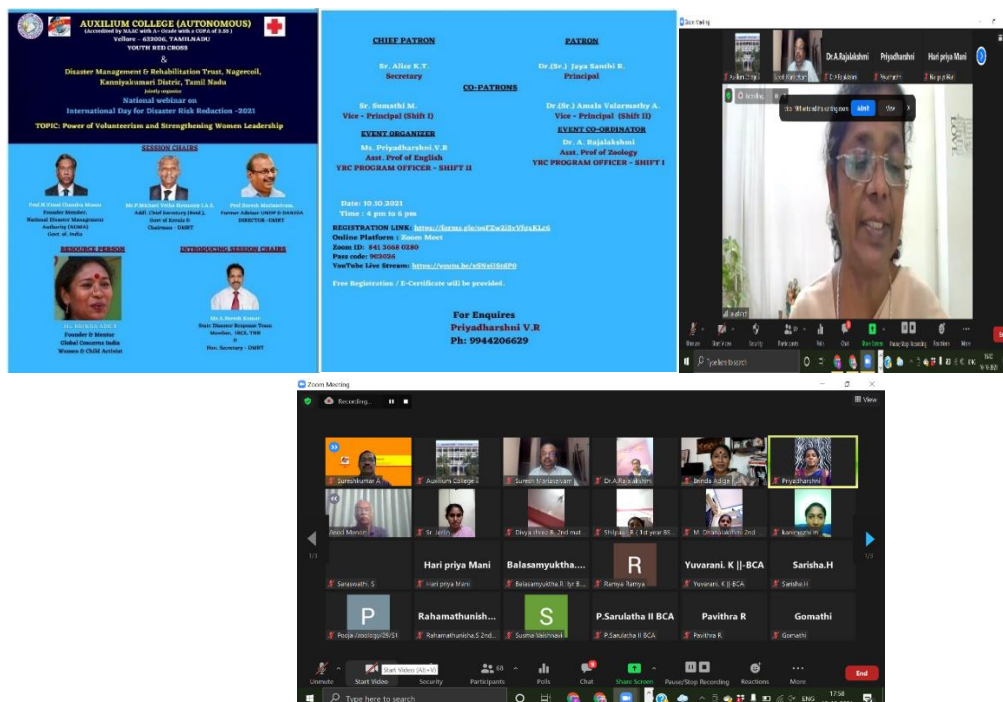
After this session their participants interacted with Mrs. Brinda Adige and shared their questions.

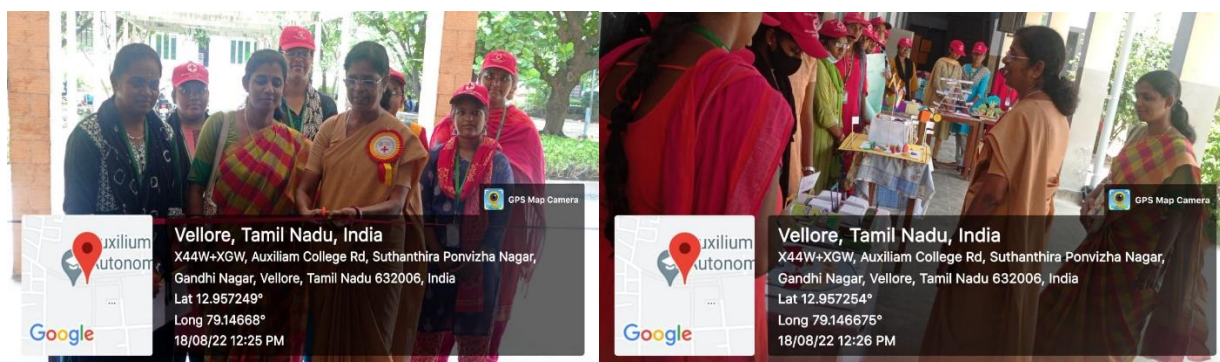
