

ROBOTIC HAND

A Robot - Perhaps even a soft, flexible one, with skin that's able to feel its surroundings - could work side by side with humans without endangering them, Yu said. The researchers applied strips of the material to the fingers of a robotic hand. The electronic skin worked as a sensor that produced different signal when the fingers bent.
