#### **International Online Webinar on ‘Circles of Salesian Research**






### Helen Fernandez Endowment Lecture





Development Strategy”. The Resource person was Dr. Anandaraj., Assistant Professor of Computer Science, Loyola College, Chennai.



## TRAINING PROGRAM





### Meri Matti, Mera Desh-Creating Amrit Vatika




### Photography Contest and Photo Expo 2023



### DEPARTMENT OF TAMIL - INTER-DEPARTMENTAL DRAMATICS


