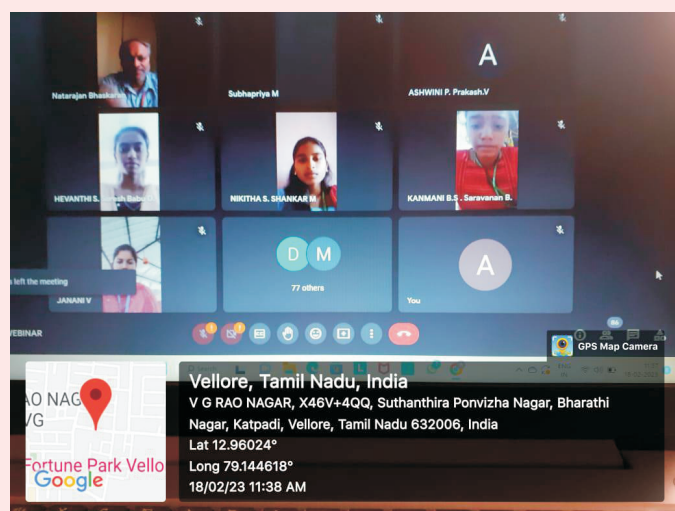
International / National Seminars / Webinars / Workshops / Conferences / Lectures

Competitions

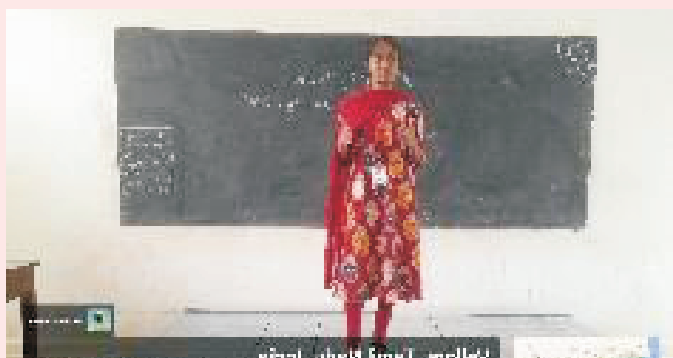

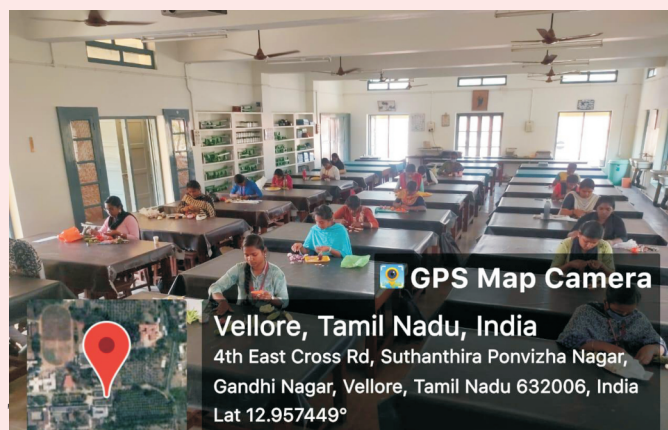
The Department of History conducted the Poster Presentation Competition on the topic “Peace” on 30th January 2023. Students from the department of History participated and won prizes.

New Initiative

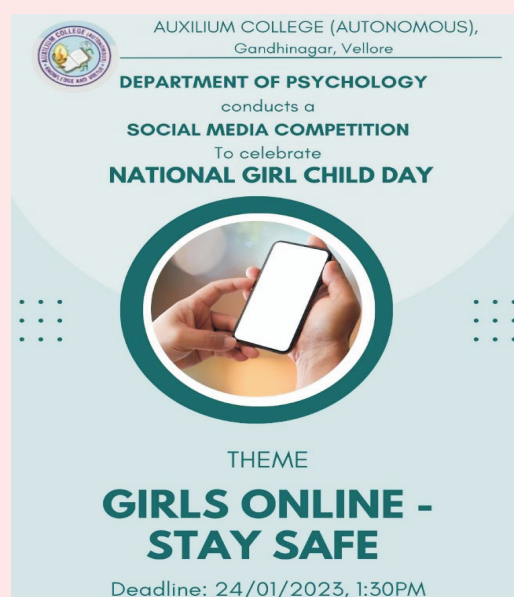
