A REPORT ON ACADEMIC AUDIT

Curriculum:

It was observed that the curriculum of the subject English was well designed with the relevant additions in the course content. The UGC recommended course on Communication skills was in place. Research programmes were conducted. The curriculum for Tamil was regarded as well laid and designed. The interdisciplinary course content was available. The feed back system from the stake holders was in operation. A well designed curriculum in Hindi was available.

In Mathematics a standardized curriculum on par with the syllabi of UGC NET, other Universities was available. The curricula of the Life Sciences subjects, Zoology and Botany were well designed with updated course content. The Feed back system was in place.

In Chemistry, the curriculum was up to date modified and well designed. Research Programmes were available. Interdisciplinary course contents were introduced. A well thought and designed curricula for UG programmes was available in Biochemistry and Microbiology as well.

The curricula for Computer sciences & Applications and Communication Media was Industry oriented and designed well . The curricula for the Management studies including BBA & MBA were designed as per the need of the Industry.

In the curriculum of Physics certain modifications were made in UG practical – General Experiments, in PG modifications were carried out in the course content of Mathematical Physics, Electronic Devices and Applications etc. to enhance the over all academic quality. The curricula of the subjects, Sociology, Social work, Commerce and History were well developed and would give the students sufficient academic learning, exposure and experience. The subject of Physical education was considered to be good. A well designed course content was available for studies in Yoga.

Suggestions:

The following suggestions were made to up keep the standards of the various academic Departments. In Mathematics skill based subject papers could be introduced as core subjects. In M.Phil. (Mathematics) programme, the Disaster Management paper is not required instead

Discrete Mathematics/Lab-R-language could be introduced. Department academic feed back should be strengthened.

In Zoology it was suggested that the faculty should apply for more Research Projects and enhance the overall research activities.

In Chemistry it was suggested to start certificated courses in Water Analysis, Waste Management, Food adulteration studies. The number of Reference Books in the Library could be increased and the same be available to the students in the Department. Visiting faculties/speakers from IISc., IITs could be arranged regularly for the benefit of the students.

In Biochemistry and Microbiology 'Learning out comes' to be included in the syllabus. Mini Projects/ Group projects could be introduced for final year students. Research laboratories could be established.

In Computer science and Applications research labs to be established. Peer reviewed Journals in the subject should be available to the students. Industrial visits/ training could be arranged. In Visual Communication/Media more number of Guest Lectures could be arranged. More field visits and interactive sessions with the Media personnel should be arranged.

In Commerce it was suggested to arrange practical training for final year B.Com students under Auditors/Income Tax practitioners.

In Social Work it was suggested the there could be 3 core subjects, 1 allied and 3 elective papers for 1st and 2nd semesters. For 2nd semester paper on Social work Research Social Policy could be introduced as core subjects.

In Physical education conducting programmes such as Yoga, Physical fitness and weight reduction could be encouraged for the benefit of the students and also could be extended to public as well. Conducting Yoga competitions for school Children, College students could be conducted periodically.


More departments should be encouraged to conduct symposia, conferences and workshops.

Extra curricular activities:

It was observed that students from all departments had participated in various extra curricular programmes such as NCC, NSS, YRC and RRC. Further special association activities were conducted by the respective departments.







