- To provide them with ongoing formation.

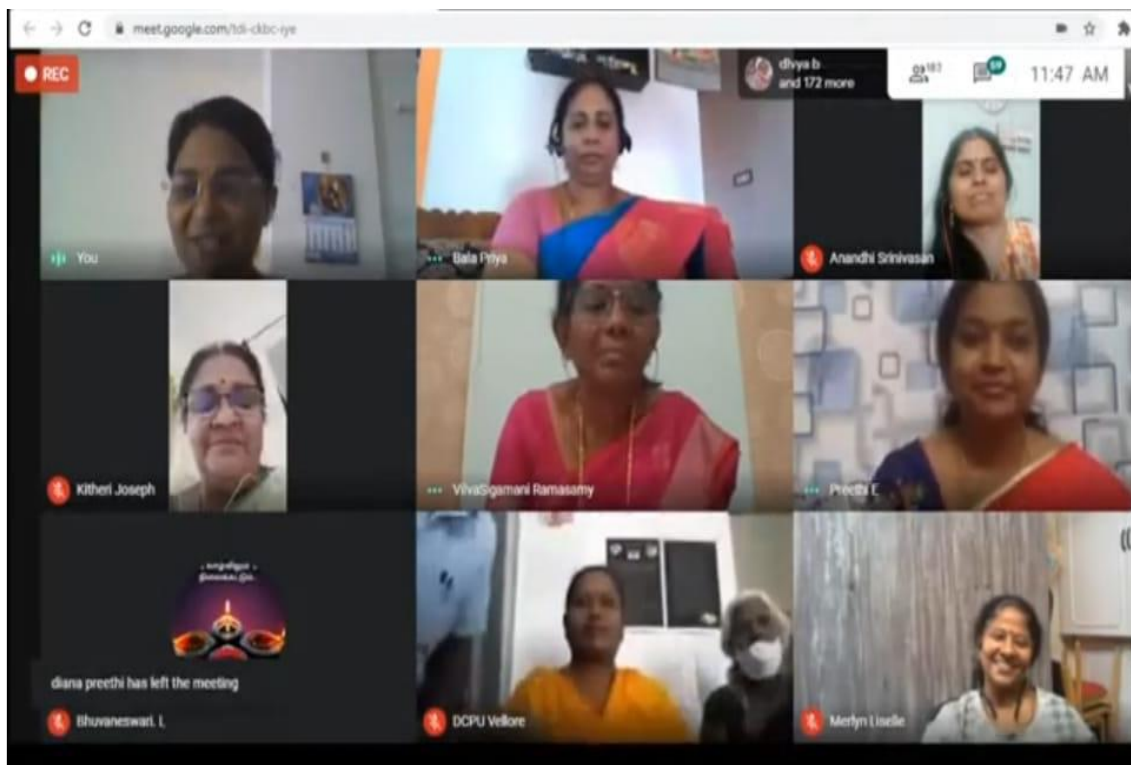
- To help the alumnae in the mission of the College to transform society through the Alumnae Association in keeping with the vision and mission of education they received.

ANNUAL ALUMNAE MEET (Virtual)

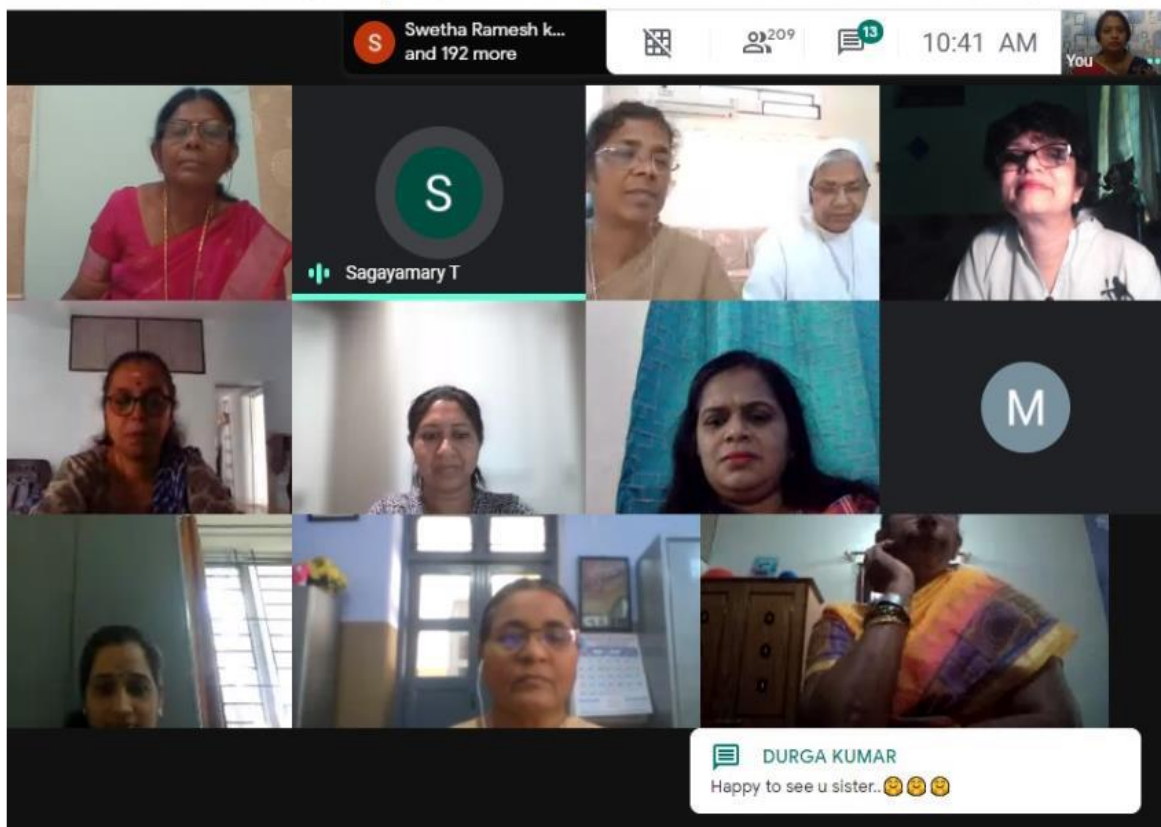
