

ANNUAL AUXILIUM ALUMNAE MEET October 2, 2022




The virtual gathering was welcomed by Sr. Sagaya Mary T, the coordinator of the Alumnae Association.














Enrolment of the Final Year Students as Alumnae June 10, 2022
