




Date: 1.10.2023 to 10.10.2023

Nearly 23 cadets participated; the program received positive feedback from both the students and the community. The practical experience of managing traffic and planting trees left a lasting impression on the cadets.






Date: 13th & 16th October 2023




Date: 19th October 2023


Event: Eve screening camp







Event: 75th Republic Day Celebration
