Capacity Building Programme

The partnership is valid from 11th September 2025 to 11th September 2026. In addition, an agreement was signed on 21st November 2025 between Auxilium College (Autonomous), Vellore, Tamil Nadu, and the Spoken Tutorial–EduPyramids–SINE IIT Bombay Nodal Resource Centre (NRC) for the Vellore region. As an NRC, Auxilium College (Autonomous) will nurture and spread awareness among colleges (cluster institutions) in Vellore and surrounding districts.
