The IQAC organised a **National Webinar on Green Campus Initiatives towards Sustainable Development on 29.07.2023**. The Resource of the programme was Dr. Bindya M. Varghese., Dean, Department of Computer Science, Rajagiri College of Social Science, Kerala. Dr. Bindya incorporated UN Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) into the discussion on green campus initiatives. Connecting these goals to the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) criterias.
