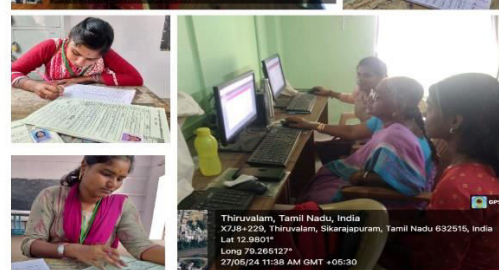
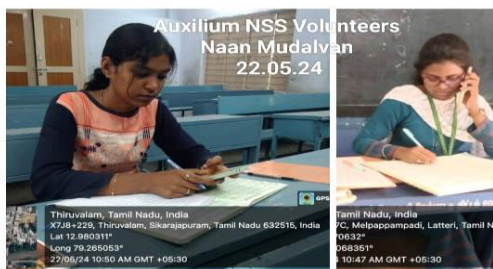

NSS volunteers created awareness on Anti-Ragging and sensitized the students by exhibiting thought provoking posters presentation.

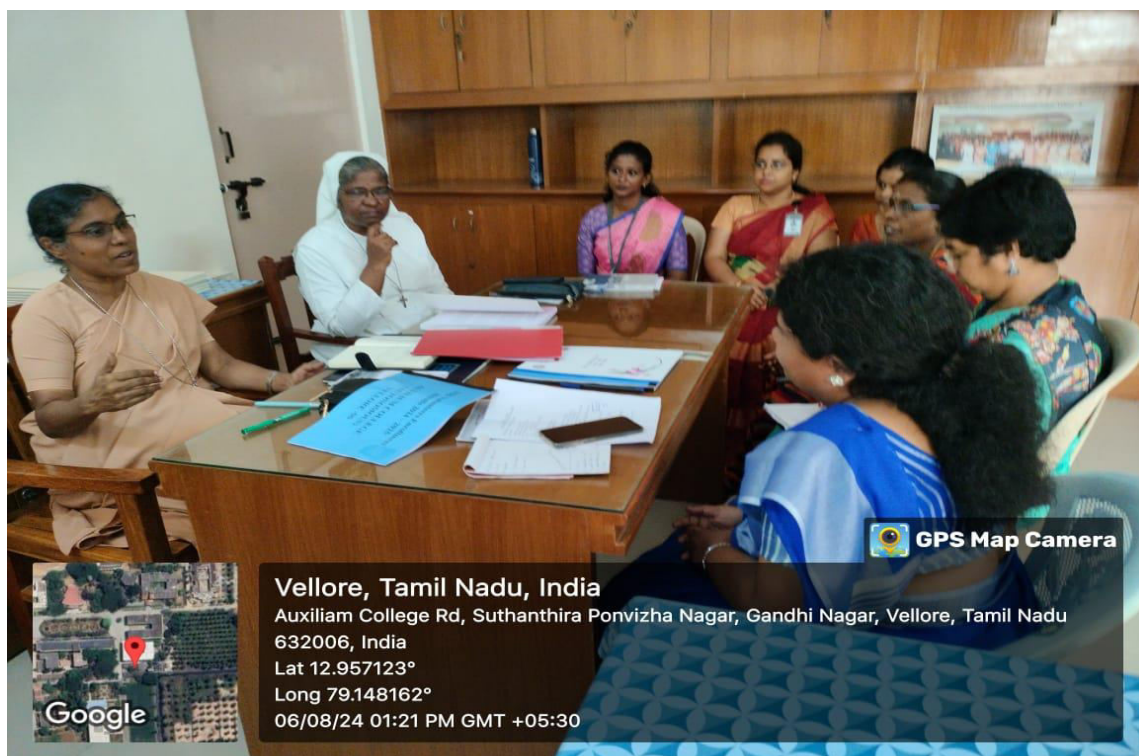


06.08.2024 : NSS Advisory Committee

The Proposed NSS Action plan for the academic year 2024-2025 was submitted for approval of the NSS Advisory Committee

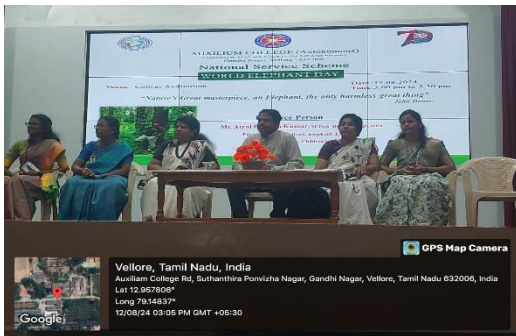


12.08.2024 : World Elephant Day

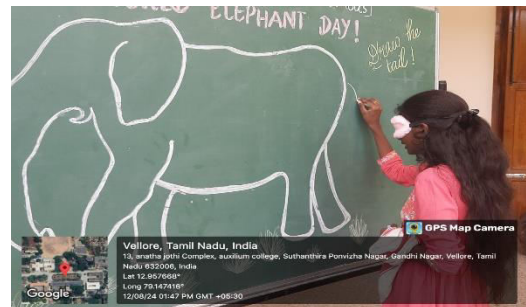

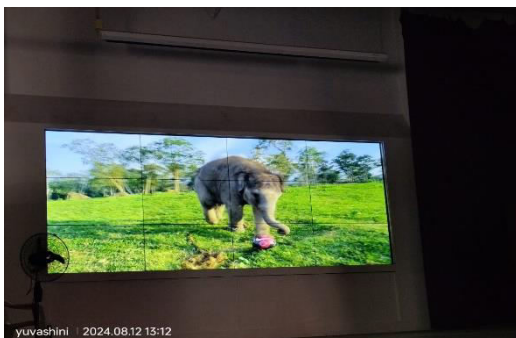

Hospital sources said that such wigs will be given to cancer survivors, who cannot afford wigs. The students were honoured with certificates by the college.

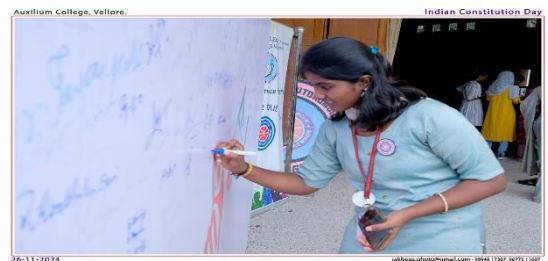

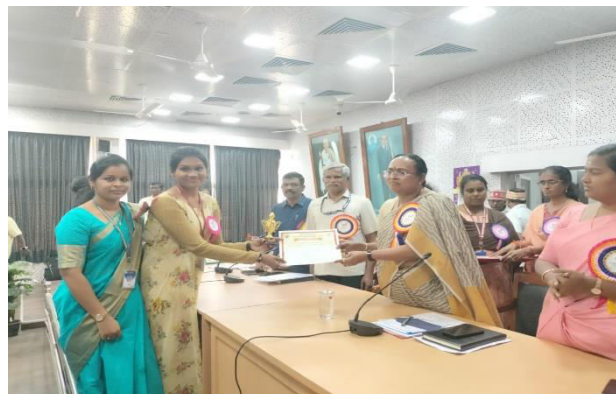
25.01.2025: National Voters Day

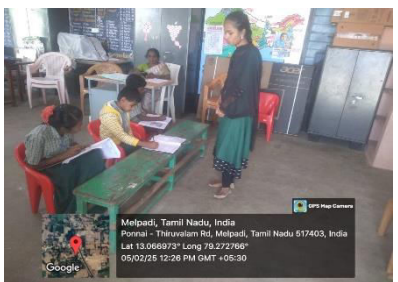

The NSS unit at Auxilium College investigates the difficulties of waste management and cleaning, investigates current success models, and makes recommendations for the application of sustainable methods. By promoting a cleaner, greener, and more sustainable environment, we may help to produce environmentally conscious individuals and contribute to a larger societal movement toward a more sustainable future. trash management includes the methodical processing of a wide range of trash produced by households and leisure activities. Maintaining the environment's cleanliness and health, as well as meeting more general environmental goals, is dependent on the implementation of effective waste management practices. This involves waste reduction methods, the execution of a recycling plan, the proper disposal of hazardous waste, and promoting awareness and education about sustainability. My Bharat's experiential learning program, supported by the central government, provides students with practical skills and hands-on experience in various sectors, effectively linking their theoretical knowledge to job opportunities, which the Auxilium NSS students utilized during their biowaste management survey.

The NSS unit took the lead with NYK and launched a 15-day ELP project on biowaste management from 13.02.2025 to 28.02.2025 in collaboration with the Vellore Municipal Corporation to raise awareness and conduct a waste management survey in Dobikana and CMC Colony, Vellore. Volunteers received comprehensive training in waste management as part of their enrolment. An Orientation programme was conducted to sensitize the environmental concerns and Dr. Susmita, Christian Medical College and Ms. Aswathi, Green Fellow, District Collectorate, Vellore served as the resource persons. As part of the Experiential Learning Programme, participants engaged in a survey, pilot study, awareness campaign, and an exposure visit to Zone 1 of the Vellore Corporation Solid Waste Management Unit.



Objectives

Waste Management is a crucial aspect of maintaining a clean and sustainable environment and engaging in waste management activity with the municipal corporation.

1. Assessment and Survey Collection:

- The students collected a waste audit to understand the types and quantities of waste generated in the respective area.
- The students identified areas with high waste generation such as hotels, shops and houses.

2. Educational Campaigns on Waste Management:

- The students have created awareness among the people about the importance of waste management and its impact on the environment.
- They have explained the public to implement a waste segregation system (e.g., recyclables, non – recyclables, organic waste).
- Provided enough information on what items go into the different bins and why segregation is important.

3. Composting:

- The students have explained to introduce composting for organic waste generated in their house, such as food scraps and garden waste.

4. Reduce Single – Use Plastics:

- Promoted the use of reusable items (water bottles, bags, containers) and discourage the use of single – use plastics.

5. Monitoring and Evaluation:

- Kept records on waste management survey, including the amount of waste discarded in a house, types of waste discarded, survey of recyclable and non-recyclable waste discarded in a house.
