


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## **BEAUTICIAN AND DECORATIVE PLATE TRAINING**






### TRUMA FIRST RESPONDER TRAINING PROGRAM

DATE: 23.02.2024

TIME: 9.00 AM – 1.30 PM





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Auxilium College (Autonomous) Youth Red Cross conducted a hands-on training on the "Trauma First Responder Training Program" in collaboration with the Department of Trauma Surgery, CMCH, Vellore, and The Hope Foundation (RCPSG) on February 23, 2024, at Library Block Seminar Hall.

Dr. Sukriya Nayak, Trauma Center, CMCH Vellore, was the course coordinator. He inaugurated the session, and Dr.Krishnan Ragavendren, Professor of Surgery at the University of Michigan Medical School, graced the occasion. A team of doctors from CMCH were the course instructors. Ms. Priyadharshni V.R., Assistant Professor of English and YRC District Organizer, welcomed the gathering.

The workshop sessions focused on the introduction and brief of the program, an overview of trauma, the biomechanics of injury, road safety, an introduction to ABCD-Moulage, and videos. Pretest, posttest, and valedictory. All students were given hands-on experience of dressing the wound, applying different types of bandages, splinting the injured body part, providing cardiopulmonary resuscitation, and transferring the victim. There was active participation by all the students, and they expressed that the session was very useful for them to meet emergencies in college and at home. Dr. Latha E., Assistant Professor of English, proposed the vote of thanks. The program was organized by Ms. Priyadharshni V.R. A certificate of appreciation was awarded to Auxilium College, Dr. Latha, and Ms. Priyadharshni V.R. for organizing this program at CMCH.
