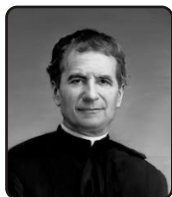

AUXILIUM COLLEGE (Autonomous)

Auxilium College founded in 1954 is the first women's college in Vellore District and is affiliated to the Thiruvalluvar University. Auxilium College had been granted the status of autonomy by the UGC and the Thiruvalluvar University from the academic year 2007- 2008. The college was accredited by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) with an A⁺ grade in 2003. In 2010, in the second cycle, it was recognized with an A grade and a CGPA of 3.41 out of 4. The 3rd cycle in 2016 resulted in an A⁺ grade with a CGPA of 3.55 out of 4. The college is currently holding an A⁺ Grade with a CGPA of 3.47 out of 4 in the 4th cycle of assessment and accreditation in May 2024. The college has consistently committed itself to nation building and the empowerment of young women for seven decades and proudly celebrated the platinum jubilee.

It is a minority institution established and administered by the Daughters of Mary Help of Christians, commonly known as Salesian Sisters of Don Bosco, belonging to the Catholic Church. It is primarily meant for higher education for deserving Catholics but members of other communities are also admitted without reference to caste or creed and their rights of conscience are respected.

The college has adopted the principles and methods of St. John Bosco, the greatest educator of the 19th century and Founder of the Salesian Society. The characteristics of Salesian Youth Spirituality (SYS) - commitment to one's duty, filial relationship with God, spirit of service, joy and a friendly rapport with all, characterizes life in the college campus. Higher education provides a particular perspective for interpreting the classic binomial of Don Bosco that expresses part of the Salesian educational objectives: "Good Christian and Upright Citizen." Education can bring a new paradigm of the typical Salesian relationship between Christian faith and citizenship. Mother Mary in Her attitude of openness to God and others is a model for all.

Vision : The vision of the college is to educate young women especially the poorest to become empowered and efficient leaders of integrity for the society.

Mission : To impart higher education to the economically weak, socially backward and needy students of Vellore and address national and international needs through education.

Pope Leo XIV

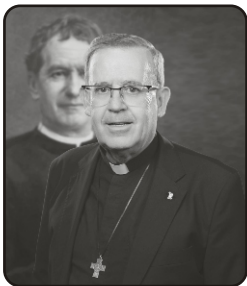

RULES AND CODE OF BEHAVIOUR

Auxilium College regards each student as a unique individual with inherent talents and a distinct personality, meant to be cultivated and perfected. Auxilium creates a stable environment through rules and regulations by establishing order, promoting safety, ensuring fairness, defining boundaries, providing guidance, encouraging accountability, supporting growth, protecting rights and fostering social harmony. In an ambience that foregrounds constructive conformity, Auxilians emerge as committed integral individuals.

General

1. The college is devoted to learning and every Auxilian should put in her best efforts for regular and concentrated study.
2. Students should wear their identity card in the college campus.
3. Use of mobile phones within the campus and taking photos/videos/selfies is barred.
4. Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited within both the college and hostel premises, and any student found engaging in such activities that impact the physical, emotional, or moral well-being of others will face severe consequences as per the Anti-Ragging Law.
5. Posting of unpleasant/ unacceptable/ damaging statements and views about the college and staff in social media is strictly forbidden.
6. Students shall obtain the Principal's permission before addressing public meetings, participating in press interviews, or publishing articles.
7. Examination rules and regulations are published on the College website. All students and parents are advised to visit the website regularly to stay informed.

8. Each student has a mentor directly in charge of her integral formation. Students should make use of the opportunity.
9. Since English is the medium of instruction, students should speak in English in the college.
10. The college and hostel are above discriminatory politics and stand for all communities. Therefore, cliques and party groups will be severely dealt with, even to the point of expulsion.
11. Staff and students are forbidden to organize any meeting in the college premises or collect money for any purpose or print and distribute any material without the prior permission of the Principal.
12. Usage of helmet for two-wheeler riders is mandatory and the vehicles shall to be parked in the respective places.
13. Students and staff shall refrain from words or actions that may disrupt unity and harmony within the campus.
14. Students shall cooperate with the authorities in keeping the premises clean and tidy.
15. While handling any property in the college, any damage caused casually or deliberately shall entail disciplinary action, recovery of cost and fine.
16. Every student should be prepared to stay in the college campus on any day before or after the class hours as per the requirement for participation in the various co-curricular and extracurricular activities like NSS, NCC, Clubs and Movements, Association activities, Sports and Games, Physical Education and other formative programmes. Any exception to this shall be granted only by the Principal.
17. By the very fact of joining the college, students agree to observe the rules and regulations of the college. The decision of the Principal shall be final in all matters of discipline and enforcement of rules.

DRESS CODE

Students shall dress neatly, decently and modestly following the rules of etiquette appropriate to the educational ambience. Violations shall result in strict action.

FEES REGULATIONS

1. The semester fees shall be paid on or before the date indicated in the college calendar.
2. Students who fail to pay the semester fees and the examination fees shall not be allowed to write the examinations.
3. If the student is on roll the Semester fees shall be paid even if she is absent.

Attendance : Norms & Guidelines

1. The College has prescribed the following regulations with regard to the number of working days and attendance as per University Regulations. The College will work for a minimum period of 90 days/ 450 instructional hours per semester.
2. Attendance shall be taken at the beginning of every hour. A student who is not in class when the attendance is taken will be marked absent.
3. A minimum of 75% of attendance is a pre-requisite to write the semester Examination and the award of Scholarship of any kind. If a student has attendance between 65% and 74% the college permits them to take the semester exams upon a payment of prescribed condonation fee.
4. If the attendance of the students is between 55% to 65% in a semester, she is not eligible to appear for the current semester examinations.
5. Students having below 55% of attendance are not eligible to write the semester examinations, they should repeat the semester.
6. Study leave for the purpose of preparing for the examination and such attendance shall not be taken into account for the purpose of minimum number of working days or for earning attendance.

7. A student entering the College late for the assembly shall not be admitted in class unless she produces the College Calendar with the 'late' entry in the late attendance record
8. Attending Faith Formation classes for Catholics and Value Education classes for other religion students is mandatory.
9. A student requiring leave from a class must apply for it in person to the staff-in-charge of that class. If she wishes to leave the college, she should meet the Head of the Department and Vice Principal to get the consent. If she is a hosteller she should also get the consent from the Dean of Residential Students as well.
10. No student shall absent herself without prior permission. Application for leave shall be made well in advance to the HoD in the form provided. When absence is due to unforeseen circumstances, application for leave should be submitted on the first day of return. During college working hours no student shall meet parents, relatives and friends.
11. Staff and students shall be present on the first working day after any short or long vacation and on the last working day of every semester. Absence on these days without adequate reason will be viewed seriously.
12. No exemption shall be granted from Continuous Assessment (CA) Examinations and Semester Examinations (SE) unless for reasons of grave necessity which must be proved to the satisfaction of the Principal. In case of illness, a medical certificate from a doctor recognized by the College should be produced.

Physical Training

A 40-hour physical fitness program is mandatory for all first-year students. Every student shall complete the Physical Training recommended by the college, which includes field sports, games, and physical exercise.

LIBRARY

Diamond Jubilee Memorial Library

The library is the center of the academic and research activities of the institute. Its mission is to provide collections and services that support the institution's educational goals. The college is proud of its library housed in a three-storey building with a rich collection of resources. All routine functions of the library are automated with the help of Autolib Integrated Library Management Systems (ILMS) and Radio Frequency Identification (RFID).

STAR READER

The **Star Reader** initiative is designed to foster a culture of reading, lifelong learning, and intellectual curiosity among both students and teaching staff by recognizing and rewarding consistent library usage and reading habits. Every month, the library identifies the Best Reader separately for students and teaching staff based on their active engagement with library resources.

Library Rules

1. Students, Teaching and Non-Teaching Staff of the College are members of the library. Identity Cards are compulsory for entry into the library.
2. 20 reading hours per semester is mandatory for all the UG students.
3. Membership Identity Cards are not transferable and ID holders would be responsible for the books issued against the ID.
4. Usage of mobile phones is strictly prohibited.
5. The fine charged for an overdue is Rs 3/-per day.

The Career Guidance and Placement Cell

The Career Guidance and Placement Cell offers programmes on Personality Development, Leadership Training, Soft Skill Training and Mock interviews. Campus interviews are also arranged periodically. The institution organise various CSR Training programmes for the final year students.

AUXILIUM COLLEGE HOSTEL

Auxilium College Hostel an ideal home, serves as an abode to students who will acquire independence, social skills, friendship, self- discovery, and transformative experiences. The college hostel which is under the direct management of the salesian sisters, ensures the constant presence, guidance and mentoring of the Deans of residential students and creates an atmosphere that instills joy, optimism and progression in the personal and academic frontiers, thus playing an important role in creating integrally formed women and transformed individuals.

Students found guilty of disobedience, theft or insincerity will be summarily dismissed especially when a timely warning has proved ineffective.

Students are permitted to go home for the semester holidays, and on the second and fourth weekends of every month.

No hosteller may be called to meet the visitors during college hours except with the express permission of the Principal. Students must promptly notify the Principal regarding any change in residence and obtain advance written permission within three days, from the Dean of residential students, to vacate the hostel.

Staff and students residing in the hostel shall be under the disciplinary supervision of the Dean of residential students and her assistants, and may freely approach them for help.

THE ALUMNAE ASSOCIATION

The Alumnae Association of Auxilium College is registered under the Indian Trust Act. The Alumnae Association of Auxilium College is part of the Chennai Province (INM) Alumnae Association which comes under the World Confederation of the Alumnae of the Salesian Sisters (FMA)

established in the year 1908 and is one of the sectors of the Salesian Family under the governance of the Councillor for the Salesian Family. “Roots in the heart, Hands in the world” is the guiding force of the Association. Every Alumnae works for the affirmation of values where the dignity of a person is concerned, working in different fields - in the family and work places, in socio-political fields and social communication. Besides the department meetings and activities of the Alumnae, the Annual Alumnae Meet will be held on the second Saturday of October every year.

Objectives

1. To afford financial help for educational institution, more particularly at Auxilium College (Autonomous), Gandhi Nagar, Vellore.
2. To provide scholarship to the students at all levels of their education in Auxilium College.
3. To contribute towards national, charitable, scientific and useful purposes.
4. To conduct educational and social awareness programmes in the villages.
5. To provide assistance to persons affected by natural calamities.

FROM TAMIL NADU EDUCATIONAL RULES

“Art 90 (a) Colleges - If a college student fails to pay her fee on the day fixed for payment, a fine at the rate of Re.1/- per working day shall be levied. If the fee is not paid by the end of the month, the student's name shall be struck off the rolls. If re-admitted, she shall in addition to the fees and fine due from her, pay a readmission fee of rupee one.”

- * Absence from the College whether with leave or without leave forms no ground for exemption from this rule.
- * Scholarship holders have the same obligation regarding payment of fees.

CHAPTER VII

Graduate and undergraduate students on the roll of colleges are forbidden to take active part in political agitation directed against the authority of the Government. Principals may further, at their discretion, forbid students to engage prominently in any public movement with which it seems undesirable that persons in StatuPupilarum should be associated.

If students attend political meetings, or conduct themselves in any manner which is forbidden or unbecoming or engage in political agitation in such a way as to interfere with the corporate life and educational work of the college, the Principal of the college may suspend or expel them or refuse the grant of their certificate for a specified period and may also report their case to the University with a view to their being dealt with under the University regulations.

Principal or other constituted College or Hostel authorities may frame and issue from time to time disciplinary rules of a permanent or temporary character, regulating the conduct of postgraduate and undergraduate students outside the College or Hostel precincts so far as such rules seem necessary (a) to secure the observance of the above rules (b) to maintain the credit and reputation of the college and hostel.

Principals of the constituted college or hostel authorities shall have full power to inflict the following punishments: fine, loss of attendance, loss of term certificates, suspension or expulsion.

I, being a citizen of India owing my unswerving and wholehearted allegiance to the Constitution, am aware that untouchability is abolished under our Constitution. I do hereby solemnly declare that I shall not by any word, deed or thought, observe or practice, consciously or subconsciously, social discrimination in any form based on untouchability against any individual. I am also aware that it is my duty to work sincerely and faithfully towards the creation of a free and casteless society in accordance with the letter and spirit of the Constitution. I do solemnly declare that it shall be a sincere expression of my complete loyalty to the Constitutions of India.
