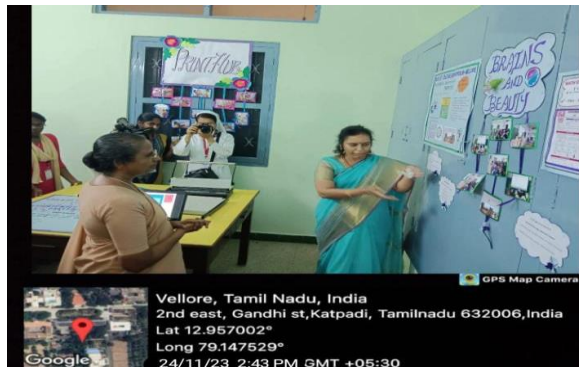

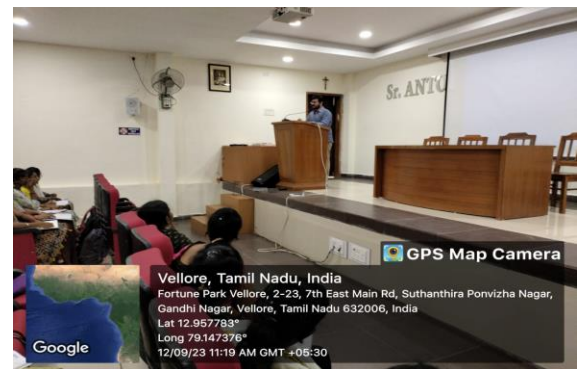

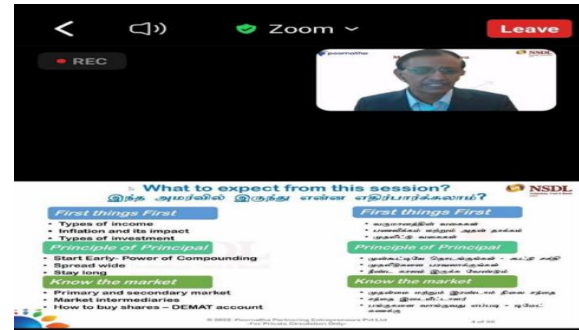

The Department of Commerce (Banking and Insurance) in collaboration with National Securities Depository Limited organized a

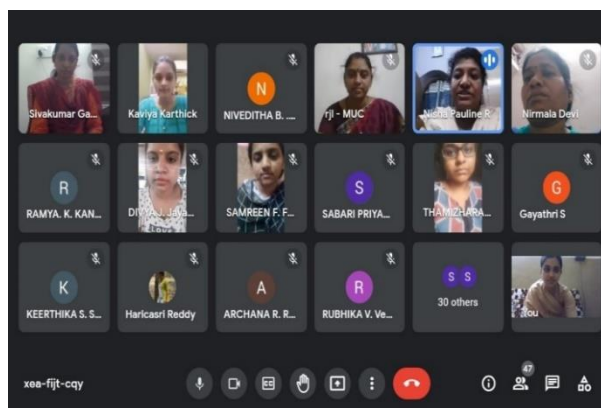


The IQAC of Auxilium College in collaboration with National Intellectual Property Awareness Mission (NIPAM) held

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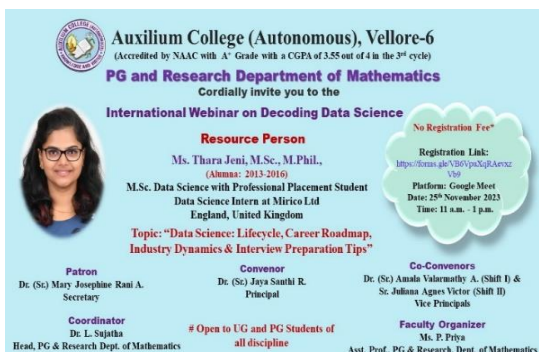

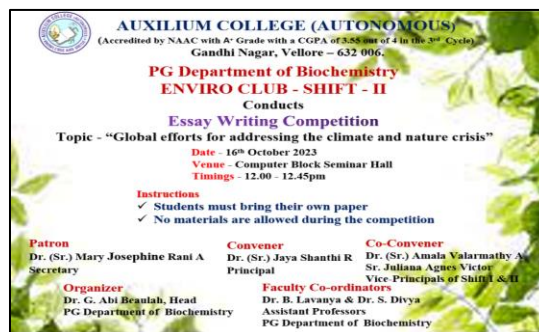

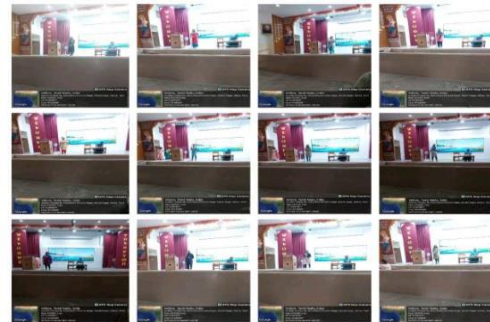
The International Eco Club Student Chapter Inauguration in association with S

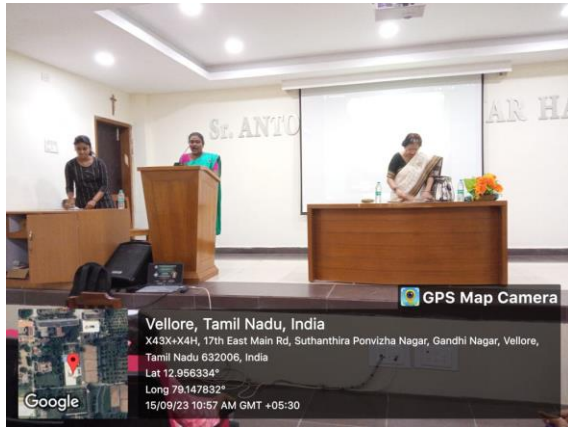

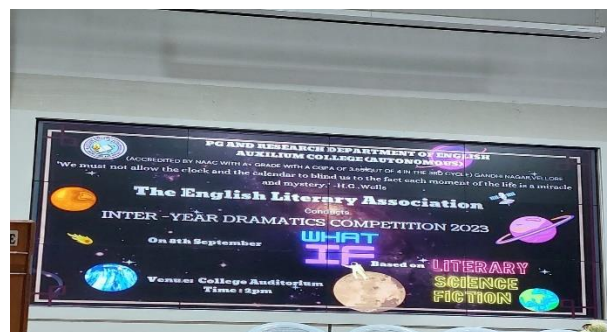

The Department of Mathematics organized a Quiz program on 5<sup>th</sup> October 2023. Eighteen students participated in this competition from the department and won the prizes

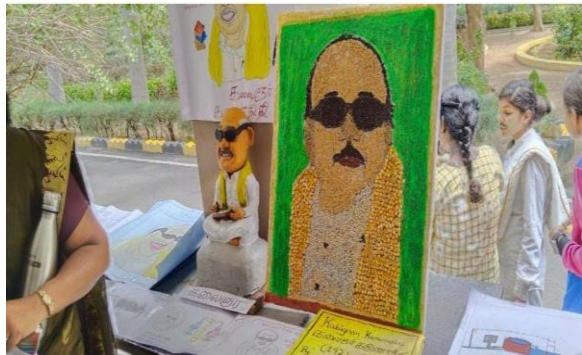
