




#### OBSERVATION OF DAYS OF NATIONAL/ INTERNATIONAL IMPORTANCE




NSS organised the "Unity Run" in celebration of the birth **Anniversary of Sardar Vallabhai Patel** on 30th October 2022. All the students participated actively.


**FIELD TRIP**




#### **NEW INITIATIVES**
